





Our elections come early this year on October 7th!

Our Nominating Committee is now in full swing. Forrest Reed, Daryl Silva, Randy Weeton, Barbara Ann Patanode and Dorothy Mueller will be putting together a slate of candidates to be announced at the August Board meeting. It's time to throw your hat in the ring!

I thought it would be helpful to post article 13 of our Bylaws pertaining to elections:

Article XIII

ELECTION OF OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS

Section 1.

On or before the first day of September of each year, the Commodore shall appoint, subject to the approval of the Board of Directors, a Nominating Committee of five members who shall within thirty days report to the Commodore, its nominations for all Officers and Directors to be filled at the bi-annual General Membership Meeting to be held in fall of each year. The Nominating Committee shall consist of one past or present Commodore, one Director and three Regular Memberships.

Section 2.

The report of the Nominating Committee shall be posted on the bulletin board in the Clubhouse immediately thereafter.

Section 3.

One of the semi-annual meetings of the General Membership shall be held in the fall of each year, in accordance with Article X, Section 1 of the Bylaws, by mailing to each Membership a notice of such meeting at least ten days prior. At such meeting, further nominations may be made from the floor.

Section 4.

The election of all Officers shall be held at the Semi-Annual Meeting. A majority vote of the Regular memberships shall elect to office. Voting shall be by written ballot, absentee votes will be accepted.


Section 5.
